When film star Lauren Bacall came to town last year, she asked her handlers to find an old-fashioned pharmacy where she could lunch. Perhaps it was her inner Lana Turner yearning to be rediscovered that led her to do just that at Highland Park Pharmacy. Opened in 1912, this veteran is still a throwback to the glory days of unique candies, home remedies, and soda shops. The menu is short and filled with nostalgic noshes such as grilled cheese, homemade chicken salad, and pimento cheese sandwiches served on Sunbeam bread and garnished with a pickle chip.
