

Carhops at the Highland Park Pharmacy provided curbside service to hungry and thirsty customers in North Dallas in the 1920's. The drive-in phenomenon became a national craze after World War II and still lingers at some famed Dallas establishments, such as Keller's Drive-ins. However, the pharmacy, located at Travis and Knox streets, dropped its curb service long ago. But the store, owned by Bolin Thell since 1973, still offers another anachronism — fountain service for sodas and ice cream. □
